Vladimir Bozhilov has a PhD from the Department of Astronomy, Faculty of Physics at Sofia University, Bulgaria. His main scientific interests are in AGN (active galactic nucleus – quasars and blazars at high redshift), cosmology, exoplanets and habitability. He took part in the Onassis Summer School Lectures of Physics 2008 in “Cosmology: An Astrophysical Perspective” lead by Prof. John Mather, Nobel Prize winner for 2006.

Since 2010, Mr. Bozhilov is an active science communicator. He won second prize in FameLab – Bulgaria 2010 competition for science communication and took part in the first national TV-show for popular science (“Beautiful Science”), aired on the Bulgarian National Television (BNT) in 2011. He also co-authored a book (“Life and Universe”) on exoplanets and habitability and has published numerous articles in various journals for popular science (“BBC Knowledge – Bulgaria”, “8” Magazine, “Objects” etc.). He is a frequent guest in various television and radio shows.
