Professor of International Law, University of Western Sydney

Steven Freeland is Professor of International Law at the University of Western Sydney, Australia, where he teaches both postgraduate and undergraduate students in International Criminal Law, Commercial Aspects of Space Law, Public International Law, Human Rights Law and International Moot Court. He is also Associate Head of School (Research) and coordinator of the School's International Law Mooting Program.

He is a Visiting Professor in International Law at the University of Copenhagen, Denmark and a Member of Faculty of the London Institute of Space Policy and Law, and has taught courses and presented guest lectures at Universities in The Netherlands, Austria, Italy, Germany, Bulgaria, United Kingdom, New Zealand, Denmark, United States, Australia and Singapore.

He has also been a Visiting Professional within the Appeals Chamber at the International Criminal Court, The Hague, a member of the Australian delegation to the United Nations Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space, Vienna, and a Special Advisor to the Danish Foreign Ministry in matters related to the International Criminal Court.
